

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
D Y PATIL UNIVERSITY,
AND
[CLINICAL NURSING RESEARCH SOCIETY]
[ABU ROAD, RAJASTHAN, INDIA]
ON
[CNRS RESEARCH ETHICAL APPROVAL]

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made between **[CLINICAL NURSING RESEARCH SOCIETY]** (hereinafter referred to as "[CNRS]"), [a non-profit organization aims to encourage and improve the quality of clinical research in nursing to generate evidence and its application in clinical practice and education at par with Global Nursing Standards, located in Saroj Lalji Mehrotra Global Nursing College, Abu Road, Rajasthan, India] and **D Y PATIL UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF NURSING** (hereinafter referred to as "DYPUSON"), a private School of Nursing located in Navi Mumbai, (address) each wishing to establish a cooperative research relationship through mutual interests in the areas of **[CNRS Research Ethical Approval]**.

([CNRS] and DYPUSON will hereinafter be referred to collectively as "Participants" or individually as "Participant", as applicable.)

WHEREAS [CNRS] and DYPUSON are linked by common scientific and cultural interests in **[Research Ethical Approval]**;

WHEREAS [CNRS] and DYPUSON wish to enable cooperation and exchange in the **[Research Ethical Approval]**; and

WHEREAS [CNRS] and DYPUSON wish to expand the basis for friendship and educational exchange.

technologies, and confidential information that may arise under this MOU.

2.4 Tasks for Participants. Each Participant will maintain regular and reasonable contact with the other Participant and engage in discussions regarding [Ethical Approval] collaboration and the research activities listed herein. Further, each Participant will nominate members of its senior staff to be responsible for overseeing matters pertaining to this MOU.

2.5 Funding. Specific funding allocations for the exchange of faculty, staff, and graduate student researchers ("Participating Researchers"), shall be subject to the approval of the individual Participant and are not binding as a result of this MOU. Except as may be stipulated in any specific subsequent agreement, each Participant shall be responsible for expenses incurred by its employees under this MOU.

2.5.1 Each Participant will provide assistances and/or the necessary letters of invitation or affiliation to facilitate the visa applications of Participating Researchers.

2.5.2 Participants shall be responsible for ensuring Participating Researchers have adequate medical insurance coverage, applicable in the country of the host Participant, for the duration of their visits.

ARTICLE III

(Duration, Termination and Amendment)

3.1 Duration. This MOU shall remain in force for one (1) year from the date of the last signature. Either Participant may terminate this MOU by providing 60 days' advance written notice to the other Participant.

3.2 Extension and Renewal. The Participants may extend or renew this MOU by agreement, confirmed in a written amendment signed by each Participant's authorized signatory.

3.3 Amendment. No amendment of the terms of this MOU will be effective unless made in writing and signed by each Participant's authorized signatory.

ARTICLE IV

(General Matters)

4.1 Use of Names. Except in promoting the activities proposed in Article 1.2 above among its faculty, staff, and students, neither Participant may use the name of the other Participant in any form of advertising or publicity without express written permission. The Participants will seek permission from one another by submitting the proposed use, well in advance of any deadline, to the Liaison Officers designated in Article 4.6 below.

4.2 Confidentiality. In the course of the activities under this MOU it may be necessary for the Participants to disclose Confidential Information. Unless otherwise expressly permitted in this agreement, any and all information, correspondence, financial statements, records, data, or information that is competitively sensitive and not generally known to the public, including formulations, analysis, inventions, improvements and activities of the disclosing Participant, disclosed by one Participant to the other Participant of this MOU, and other documents

3. All consumables like bags, needle cutters, disinfectants etc. shall be procured by the GENERATOR at its own cost.
4. All the bags shall be sealed tightly and labeled as per the rule by the GENERATOR and "MWML" will collect the sealed bags only from a secured designated point within the premises of the GENERATOR.
5. The GENERATOR shall disinfect the sharps, mutilate them and hand over in Puncture Proof Containers to "MWML".
6. The GENERATOR shall take all steps to ensure that the waste is handled without adverse effects to human health and environment.
7. The GENERATOR shall establish a common secured waste collection point within its premises for collection and handing over to "MWML".
8. The GENERATOR shall furnish annual report on "Form-II" regarding generation, collection and storage of Bio-Medical wastes in the prescribed format to Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.
9. The GENERATOR shall maintain all the relevant records and make reports of the accidents to MPCB, if any, on "Form-III" as prescribed under the rules.
10. The GENERATOR shall designate a "Nodal Officer" to interact with "MWML".
11. The BMW handed over by the GENERATOR may be checked and suggestions, if needed, may be provided for improvement in the segregation of waste by "MWML".
12. The GENERATOR shall obtain authorization from the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board.
13. The GENERATOR shall be solely responsible for the number of beds being declared to "MWML", which must be same for which the authorization is obtained from Maharashtra Pollution Control Board. The GENERATOR shall inform "MWML" and MPCB within 7 days about any change in the number of beds. MWML shall not be responsible for any under/over declaration by GENERATOR on this account.

Terms & Conditions

1. MWML shall charge the service of collection, transport, treatment & disposal of BMW at Rs. 6.40 (Six Rupees and Forty Paise) per bed per day for your hospital beds as per below schedule.

Monthly service charges will be applicable as per below

- From 1st November 2016 to 31st January 2017 for 900 beds.
 - From 1st February 2017 to 30th April 2017 for 1050 beds.
 - From 1st May 2017 onwards for 1250 beds.
2. Dr. D. Y. Patil Hospital & Research Centre Nerul total beds are 1250 Beds as per the declaration, monthly waste generation limit is 9375 with beds strength of 1250 if crossed the weight limit then MWML will charges Rs. 49/- per Kg.
 3. The above rates shall be increased annually by 10% on previous year's rates. The first revision will be from 1st April 2017.
 4. The no. of beds as well as quantity of waste shall be reviewed annually. The agreement may be amended suitably if required.
