Report of the Career Advancement scheme programs

A program on “Healthcare and Hospital management” was held on 3rd February 2017 in the Medical college auditorium, D Y Patil University.

The speakers were Dr. Vittal Kamble, Dr. Purnima Kandekar, Dr. Kinjal Chandra. They are eminent Occupational Therapists working in the private sector. Dr. Vitthal Kamble works at the Helen Keller Institute for the Deaf and Blind, Navi Mumbai and at the VMRC (multispecialty rehabilitation center). Dr. Kinjal Chandra is the Pediatric Occupational Therapist at Peהל, Pediatric Therapy Centre. Dr. Purnima Kandekar is a certified handwriting specialist and a consultant Occupational therapist at Hinduja Hospital and at Child Development Center.

The programme was attended by 113 students.

OBJECTIVES

1. To guide the students about the various job opportunities available to them in different hospitals and rehabilitation centers of Mumbai
2. To educate the students about the various private sectors that employ Occupational Therapists
3. To educate the students in salary for fresh graduates and negotiation skills

CONTENTS OF THE PROGRAMME

Since many students after completing their graduation wish to work in hospitals to gain a professional working experience, it was found necessary to conduct such a workshop which would guide the students about working conditions and opportunities in private hospitals and clinics.

The speakers gave a presentation about the various clinics and private hospitals that have an Occupational Therapy department set up and employ them. They also guided the students on negotiation skills and pay scales for a newly graduated Occupational Therapist.

At the end of the session, discussions were held about how the students can work as observers in private clinics before graduating, how they can take up home visits and build contacts required to establish themselves as reputable Occupational Therapists in the healthcare set up.

OUTCOMES

1. The students learned about the various areas that an Occupational Therapist can work in the private hospitals and clinics
2. The students learned that they could do observership before graduating to gain practical working experience



3. The students learned about the different agencies and healthcare organizations that employ Occupational therapists.

SUGGESTIONS FROM FEEDBACK

1. According to the feedback received from the students in the future sessions, lectures on marketing and management strategies will also be held.
2. There will be separate sessions for financial management.
