- DYPU has a Central Library, and ten Schools have their libraries. There is an Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) for students and staff.
- Library is automated using Integrated Library Management System (ILMS), which integrates all processes right from acquisition to issuance. The software used for the same are SLIM 21 & KOHA.
- All Libraries have free internet usage & Wi-Fi facilities and access to the computers for maintaining data work, projects, and research works.
- Libraries have spacious halls, dedicated collection & display section, reading rooms & IT zone, e-Library & Computerized library section. It has ensured facilities like individual reading carrels, lounge area for browsing & relaxed reading, IT zone for accessing e-resources.
- The library transactions are carried out through Bar Code Technology. The numbering system in the Library is based on the international numbering system for the books.
- Web OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) facility is made available through SLIM21 Library Management Software to know the bibliographical details about the collection. One separate node is made available in the Central Medical Library for OPAC facility. Search by giving Title, Author, and domain can be carried out.
- A well-equipped Digital Library with 18 nodes having Internet connectivity is housed in the Central Library to access e-Resources.
- Libraries have access to e-journals & books and databases like PRO-QUEST, EBSCO, JGATE, NPTEL, SWAYAM, MOOC etc.
- Access facility to e-journals is multi-user and IP address-based; students can access the E-Resources from anywhere on the campus.
- All the active book collections are updated in the SLIM21/KOHA Library Management Software database. The Web OPAC is available for the users.
- The issue and return of books have been activated with the SLIM21/KOHA Library Management Software. Library activities like data entry, issue and return and renewal of books, member logins, online book reservation, report management, acquisition control systems, articles indexing system, e-resources linkage through remote access, serial control systems report generation, User rate analysis, User data Maintenance, Storage and retrieval of data, Improved Student Service, Cataloging Improvements, selective dissemination of information, article alert service etc. carried out through software.
- One terminal is dedicated for the readers to use OPAC software to search books.

- The Library provides support to students to maintain a book bank facility and previous year's question bank of all schools in the Digital Library.
- DYPU has acquired license copy of "Turnitin" for Plagiarism check. Through this, every faculty at DYPU has login access to check on any data for Plagiarism. The Anti-Plagiarism policy is as per the apex bodies.
- DYPU has INFLIBNET and DELNET Membership.
