1) REPORT OF VIRTUAL PARENT TEACHER MEETING FOR THIRD YEAR



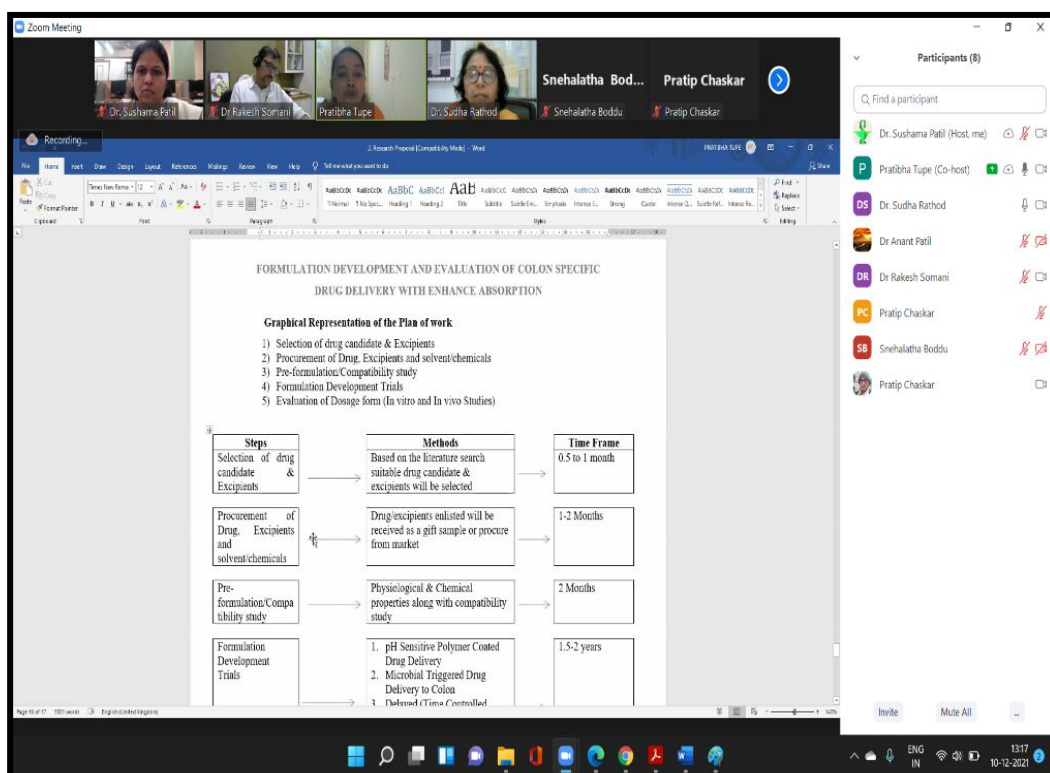

On the 22nd of December 2021, DY Patil School of Pharmacy inaugurated Vardhishnu- Activity Based Teaching Learning programme in the presence of Mr. Rahul Dongre, General manager, Milan Lab (India) Pvt. Ltd. with great ardour at the Seminar hall. Teaching, Non-teaching staff and the students were present. The objective of proposed pedagogical practice was to enhance the Pharmacognosy course learning. Exhibition of the crude drugs and charts were presented by the FYD.Pharm students. Activity was taken by Ms. Pranali Band & students were asked to collect different types of leaves and identify its part and margin. Classification of crude drugs was taught using Activity Based Teaching Learning model. Students were asked to identify the source of crude drugs and discuss the importance of crude drugs used in Traditional System of Medicines. The entire event was coordinated by Ms. Pranali Band, Assistant professor & FYD.Pharm students- Nameeta C, Omkar V, Rozelline, Lochan, Tripti & Deepak Patil.

4. To understand the need of education and healthcare



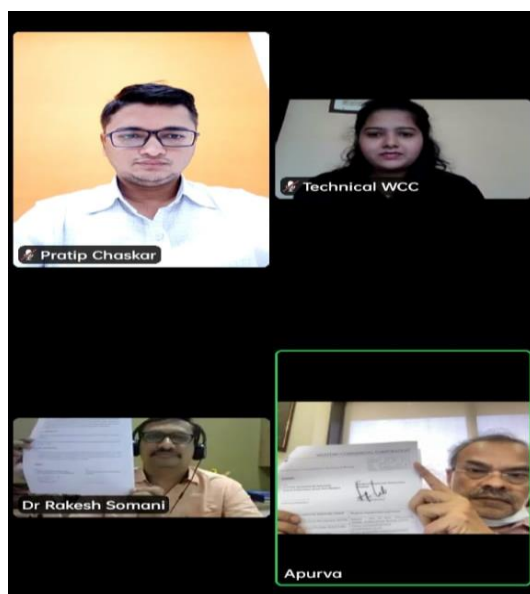
6) ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND INNOVATION AS A CAREER OPPORTUNITY
