Resources available in the institution

1) Physical facilities

Wheel Chair – Most people with disabilities depend on a wheelchair for their mobility. For these people, a wheelchair is an important way of achieving independent locomotion. We have a provision of wheelchair in the HMCT campus for the disabled. The provision of wheelchair in the college campus aids in assistance of disabled students to easily access the lifts and the other parts of the campus.

2) Provision for lift


The elevator facilitates easy and quick movement through the different floors of the college. The facility may be availed by both staff members as well as differently-abled students. A lift operator is present at all times to enable safe movement of people up and down the college. The schools main building.

3) Ramp / Rails

People with disabilities are dependent on the wheelchair for their mobility. A wheelchair user's mobility can be enhanced by provision of a ramp which is properly designed and help in easy navigation for the user as well as the handler. Because both caregivers who assist the disabled and manual wheelchair users handle wheelchairs, the slope of the ramp is important to both.







4) Rest Rooms designated

Accessible toilets are designed with large floor space to make easy in and out movement of wheelchairs and unisex compartments accessible for the wheel chair users.

6) Scribes for examination

A scribe is a person who writes down a student's dictated answers in an examination. A student is assigned a scribe if he or she has difficulty producing legible text.

We as an organisation have a provision for students who have learning disability, or problem with producing legible text to avail the facility of arranging scribes to assist them during examination.
